During the week of April 13th-17th I have been in grades 3-5. In third grade, students identified which academic skills are necessary for work and placed them in the appropriate career path (business, creative, nature, fixing, building and technology, helping or health). In fourth grade, the students visited the website www.vaview.org/k5 and took an interest inventory which generated a list of jobs. Each student then picked one job

student then picked one job from the list and researched what duties are involved, education needed, and class subjects related to this field of work. In fifth grade, the students visited the website www.acinet.org and took an interest inventory as well. From their results they picked a career to research; which included duties, education needed, salary, what colleges offer the degree, which states are in need of this career, personality traits, and subjects to excel in. Next week I will be working with small groups.
