### THREE WAYS TO INTERACT WITH THE EBOOKS:

1. Read to Me: the child listens to the book read aloud and manually turns the pages. Eighty percent of the titles are read aloud

2. Let Me Read: the read aloud is turned off so the child reads and turns the pages himself

3. Auto Play: the reader lets the computer do the work - reads aloud and turns the pages automatically

## **Counselor Corner-Mrs. Kaiser**

During the week of January 5th - 9th I have been in preschool thru second grade. In preschool we read and discussed the book *Cool Down* and Work Through Anger. In Kindergarten, we worked on self-control. We discussed as a class what self-control looks like and how we keep ourselves in control. In first grade, we played feelings charades and the audience had to guess which feeling the students were acting out. We ended class with a feeling thermometer and discussed how everyone has different feelings with the same experience and that's okay. In second grade, we did the activity bug bag and came up with coping skills we can utilize when we are feeling "bugged". Next week I will be in grades third thru fifth.

Don't forget: Join us at the end of the month for our celebration assembly! Your child may be nominated by their teacher for good character.
