Greetings Sageville families & friends,

School funding for next year is at a critical point. Our superintendent, Stan Rheingans, provided a community session to inform citizens about school funding. Funding for Iowa schools ranks 35th in the nation per pupil spending. This is unacceptable! Please contact your legislators. Currently, the funding level is at 1.25% and we need at least 4% before budget cuts will need to be made. Here is a link to find out how to contact your legislator:

You were notified as a parent of your child's individual progress in reading during February conferences. These three winter data points of MAP, DIBELS and Iowa Assessments gives you a glance of how we are doing in the area of reading at Sageville School overall.

Each of these assessments gives you and your child's teacher different information of how your child is progressing. As a school staff we look at different groups of students over time and areas of growths and strengths.

In April and May we will be assessing students in DIBELS and MAP.

Several students receive specialized instruction in the area of reading or interventions from classroom teachers, Americorp and Reading Corp.

Parents of students who qualify for the district summer reading academy are reminded that the registration form is due April 1st.
